As are many Americans, I am outraged at the unbelievable decision by Judge Lawrence K. Karlton that the “under God” portion of the Pledge violated the separation of church and state. He did so after days of fasting and prayer, convinced that this battle would have to be re-fought.

Second, I’m making my painting available to be used by conservative groups such as *The Becket Fund*, *Capitol Resource Institute*, *Traditional Values Coalition*, and *Pacific Justice Institute* in their emails and on their websites to get the message across.
